

AGU-SEG COLLABORATION COMMITTEE 2024-2025 REPORT

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The AGU-SEG Collaboration Committee strengthened ties between SEG and AGU in 2025 through impactful workshops, new cross-society initiatives, and scholarly contributions. Building on the success of the Geothermal Workshop in Salt Lake City, the committee launched planning for future events, including the 2026 Hydrogeophysics Workshop, and initiated a new webinar collaboration with AGU sections. A proposal for a special section on Geothermal Energy in GEOPHYSICS further underscores the committee's role in advancing geoscience collaboration and visibility.

HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE PAST YEAR

- **2025 Geothermal Workshop:** Held in Salt Lake City, Utah, June 16-18, followed by a June 18-19 field trip to Utah FORGE. The workshop attracted 83 participants from eight countries, representing both academia and industry, and featured more than 50 technical presentations.
- **New Joint Initiative:** In collaboration with the AGU Volcanology, Petrology, and Geochemistry Section, the committee began exploring potential topics for a new webinar series, building on shared objectives.
- **Upcoming 2026 Workshop:** Planning is underway for the joint workshop *Hydrogeophysics*, scheduled for July 20-22, 2026, in Boise, Idaho.
- **Journal Special Section:** The committee submitted a proposal to SEG Publications for a special section on Geothermal Energy in GEOPHYSICS.
